Opening

Chairperson Blowers called the meeting to order and requested a moment of silence followed by the pledge to the flag.

2025 Audited Financial Statements Presentation by RKL, LLP

RKL presented the 2025 audited financial statements and reported an unmodified opinion. The auditors noted that the financial statements were fairly presented in all material respects, no significant deficiencies or material weaknesses were identified, and no fraud indicators or other material issues were encountered during the audit. The auditors also complimented the finance team for its prompt close process and overall professionalism. The Board questioned and discussed the accuracy of the reporting process, the level of access provided to auditors, and the use of AI within audit procedures.

Daniel Youngs, Executive Director

Mr. Youngs reported that March was a particularly strong month operationally. He explained that the Authority had rebounded from the two prior months of weaker inbound tonnages and had more than recovered those volumes in March, with the positive trend continuing into April. He attributed this improvement to the overall resiliency of the region, as well as increased construction activity and stronger waste volumes as warm weather emerged.

He also reported that the Citizens Advisory Committee had recently met and discussed waste diversion technology and the second transfer station concept. He stated that the committee had responded favorably to the Authority's proactive approach and appreciated that the Board and staff were not only addressing current operational needs but also planning strategically for the future growth of the service area.

Mr. Youngs recognized several staff members for their outreach efforts and thanked them for representing the Authority in the community. He also highlighted Nicole Roy's presentation at a Philadelphia VCIA Chapter event and expressed appreciation for the team's commitment to public education and stakeholder engagement.

Mr. Youngs introduced a resolution authorizing participation in a public auction for property near the waste-to-energy facility in Bainbridge. He explained that the parcel could serve as a strategic buffer and support future planning needs. A copy of the action item is attached.

BOARD ACTION NO. 3: RESOLUTION 2026-03: AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AT PUBLIC AUCTION, IN LIEU OF CONDEMNATION, OF A PARCEL OF REAL ESTATE IN CONOY TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY, KNOWN AS 290 LOCUST GROVE ROAD, CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 10.5 ACRES

Mr. Youngs then introduced a focus topic on the updated strategic plan, noting that the current three-year plan will conclude at the end of June. He explained that the next plan will retain the Authority's mission, vision, and core principles with only minor refinements, including language reflecting service to multiple communities across the two-county service region.

He outlined the Authority's three long-term philosophies: long-term financial and capacity planning, regulatory compliance and opportunity, and quality and safe public service. He stated that these philosophies continue to guide decision-making and strategic priorities.

Mr. Kohr, Ms. Marsh, Ms. Roy, and Mr. Bennett then summarized the Authority's 2026 to 2028 primary objectives, including landfill planning and capacity strategy, optimization of waste processing and service, stakeholder engagement and education, enhancing governance and risk management framework, and



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strengthening culture and engagement. It was noted that these priorities include ongoing work related to landfill capacity, waste conversion technology, regional coordination, strategic land acquisition, public outreach, and workforce development.

The Board emphasized the importance of ensuring that all levels of the organization remain aligned with the Authority’s mission, vision, and core principles. It was noted that ongoing communication, employee engagement, and leadership development are essential to maintaining consistency in decision-making and supporting the Authority’s long-term strategic goals. Board members asked whether the Authority was participating in any regional waste planning discussions or “think tank” efforts with other authorities and whether those conversations included neighboring counties. Mr. Youngs responded that there are a number of national and regional industry organizations, as well as more localized discussions among Pennsylvania solid waste leaders, and that those conversations have been useful for sharing ideas and addressing common regional challenges. Lastly, the Board emphasized the importance of strategic land acquisition to support future landfill capacity opportunities.

Mr. Youngs concluded by stating that the strategic plan presentation was for discussion only and that a final one-page version would be brought back for Board consideration at the May Board meeting.

Richard Bennett, Director of Finance

Mr. Bennett presented the March 2026 financial report and reviewed inbound tonnage, revenues, expenses, general and administrative costs, net income, EBITDA, and unrestricted reserves. He reported that March was a strong month and that first quarter performance remained favorable, with volumes recovering from earlier months and trending positively into April.

ISSUE: Purchase of Equipment for 2026 Delivery

BACKGROUND: LCSWMA utilizes a cyclical equipment replacement schedule, with replacement frequency based on utilization rate, maintenance costs, and residual value of each type of equipment. 
DISCUSSION: LCSWMA continues to use cooperative bidding and purchasing contracts whenever possible to secure equipment at the most competitive price. Staff will determine appropriate means for disposal, trade-in, or auction of any retired equipment for which this new equipment replaces. This purchase represents the second of several equipment batch purchases planned for 2026.

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors (“Board”) of the Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania (“LCSWMA”), has determined that it is appropriate to take steps to acquire a tract of real estate totaling approximately 10.5 acres located in Conoy Township, County of Lancaster, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (the “Property”);

WHEREAS, the Property, owned by Richard W. and Patricia Eichorn, consists of approximately of a 1.0 acre homestead, 0.5 acre cropland, 1.2 acre woodland, and 7.8 acre pasture, improved with an approximately 3,700 square foot two story home, attached garage and bank barn, and is more fully described in Exhibit “A” which is attached to and made a part of this Resolution;

WHEREAS, LCSWMA, as a municipal authority organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, has the legal authority and power to appropriately acquire by eminent domain real estate for the use of LCSWMA;

WHEREAS, the Property will be offered for sale by Hess Auction Group at a public auction scheduled for Thursday, April 23, 2026 at 6:00 p.m., with ten percent down on the day of sale and the balance due in sixty days (the "Auction"); and

WHEREAS, LCSWMA has obtained an appraisal of the value of the Property (the “Appraisal”) from Sisco Appraisal, Inc., a Pennsylvania State Certified appraisal firm;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that Daniel G. Youngs, LCSWMA’s Executive Director (the “ExD”), is authorized and directed to take all actions in the ExD’s discretion, which are necessary or appropriate for LCSWMA to bid at the Auction for the Property and, if LCSWMA’s bid for the Property is successful, to acquire the Property, by Deed in lieu of condemnation for the Auction bid price;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board that all prior actions by ExD in connection with acquisition of the Property, including but not limited to obtaining the Appraisal, inspecting the Property, agreeing to the Conditions of Sale, and, if appropriate, obtaining, are hereby ratified and approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board that: (a) the ExD’s bidding authorization is not limited by the valuation stated in the Appraisal, and (b) the ExD is authorized and directed on behalf of LCSWMA to pay the down payment on the date of the Auction, to execute the Purchaser’s Agreement, to pay the balance of the bid price within 60 days of the date of the

Auction, to obtain a Deed in Lieu of Condemnation for the Property, and to execute all documents and take all other steps the ExD shall deem appropriate and in the best interests of LCSWMA.


ISSUE: Award of Contract for Solid Waste Permitting Services for a New Solid Waste Transfer Station

BACKGROUND: The development and operation of a Solid Waste Transfer Station requires a solid waste permit from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP). The preparation of a PADEP solid waste permit application requires both onsite field investigations and a desktop review of available information to ensure a proposed transfer station meets all regulatory requirements and guidelines. In addition, the permit outlines the planned operations of the facility including facility hours, material types received, onsite management, etc. The permit level design, investigations, and permit application preparation are anticipated to take approximately six months to complete.

DISCUSSION: Staff worked with our existing solid waste consultant, ARM Group of Hershey, to develop a scope of work for the permitting services required for the development of the proposed East Cocalico Transfer Station Project. ARM Group provided a proposal for the services at an estimated cost of \$180,523.22. ARM Group has completed preliminary engineering reviews and analysis of the potential East Cocalico Township site as well as the engineering, design, and permitting associated with multiple other LCSWMA facilities. Staff believe ARM Group's knowledge of solid waste permitting and construction, as well as their experience with LCSWMA's facilities, make them ideally suited to complete these services.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Board of Directors award the contract for Solid Waste Permitting services for a new Solid Waste Transfer Station to ARM Group of Hershey, PA in the amount of \$180,523.22.


ISSUE: Award of Contract for Professional Engineering and Land Development Plan Preparation Services for a New Solid Waste Transfer Station

BACKGROUND: The development of any new site requires the preparation and submission of a land development plan to the county and local municipality. The land development plans must depict the overall site design including utilities, stormwater infrastructure, parking, roadways, etc., to ensure all site development meets applicable regulatory requirements and guidelines. The preparation of the land development plans and associated design calculations, drawings, field investigations, surveys, and related materials is anticipated to take approximately six to nine months to complete. Once completed, final plans will be submitted to the county and local municipality for review and approval.

DISCUSSION: Staff worked with David Miller Associates (DMA) of Lancaster to develop a scope of work for the engineering and land development services required for the development of the East Cocalico Township site. DMA provided a proposal for these services with an estimated cost of \$234,500.00. DMA has completed preliminary engineering reviews and analyses of the potential East Cocalico Township site, as well as previously performing engineering, design, and land development work associated with existing LCSWMA facilities. Staff believe DMA's knowledge of site permitting and development requirements, together with their experience with LCSWMA's facilities, makes them well suited to complete these services.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Board of Directors award the contract for Professional Engineering and Land Development Plan Preparation Services for a new Solid Waste Transfer Station to David Miller Associates of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, in the amount of \$234,500.00.

ISSUE: Award of Contract for the Frey Farm Landfill 2026 Gas System Expansion Project

BACKGROUND: As waste within the Frey Farm Landfill decomposes, it generates methane gas. This gas is collected via a system of horizontal and vertical wells and sent to the Frey Farm Landfill Gas-to-Energy plant, where it is combusted in an engine to generate electricity for sale to the grid. Periodically, as additional waste is placed in the landfill, the existing gas system must be expanded by adding additional wells to efficiently collect the landfill gas that is produced. The scope of work associated with the 2026 Gas System Expansion Project includes the installation of ten new vertical gas wells, an additional horizontal gas collector, as well as additional piping infrastructure. The 2026 Budget included \$500,000 for this project.


DISCUSSION: LCSWMA staff worked with consultants to develop drawings and specifications for the expansion project. The bid package was developed internally and based on unit prices for the installation of eleven additional gas wells. The bid results are listed below:

| Atlantic Lining Company | \$444,777.00 |

Kinsley Construction has completed similar projects at our Frey Farm Landfill in the past and LCSWMA staff are confident in their ability to complete the work. ARM Group, LLC completed a bid evaluation and confirmed that Kinsley's bid submission included all required documents and that Kinsley satisfied the required qualifications and experience.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends the Board of Directors award the contract for the Frey Farm Landfill 2026 Gas System Expansion Project to Kinsley Construction, Inc. of York, Pennsylvania in the amount of \$369,213.00.
